If you are flying in to Bristol:

Bristol International Airport: <http://www.bristolairport.co.uk>

The Bristol International Flyer coach goes to the city centre from outside the Arrivals exit. You can book tickets online, from £8.00 single and £12.00 return: <https://flyer.bristolairport.co.uk/>

A taxi from the airport to the city centre starts from around £30.00.

Parking at Bower Ashton Campus:

There is limited visitor parking at Bower Ashton Campus. If you would like to park here, please contact CFPR to arrange a permit at least ten days before the event. Your car registration number will be required.

There is also pay and display parking (£1.20 per day) at the Ashton Court car park, a short walk from the campus on Kennel Lodge Road.

(Very central option, would suit a low budget but can be noisy)

Double rooms start from around £50.00

(Close to Bower Ashton Campus, 20 min walk)

Double rooms start from around £60.00

(Has a small bar/cafe. No car park but they offer a discount scheme for the car park next door. It is in the Centre, so plenty of places to eat and drink. Recommended to ask for a quiet room away from the front of the building.)

Double rooms start from around £70.00

(Large hotel with an indoor swimming pool, within easy walking distance of Temple Meads, large car park. A quieter place to stay as it isn't on the main drag.)

Double rooms start from around £70.00

(Close to Millennium Square)

Double rooms start from around £90.00

(Good reviews from visitors. In Clifton, a 30-minute walk uphill from the city centre.)

Double rooms start from around £175.00

(Sometimes does online deals on rooms, has a swimming pool, very central, often busy with weddings on weekends)

Eating and drinking near UWE City Campus

UWE staff will have good recommendations, but some to note for now are:

- *The Hope & Anchor*, 38 Jacobs Wells Rd, also does good beer and honest food, and has a small beer garden – and is a short walk from Bower Ashton.
- *Tobacco Factory*, Raleigh Road, Southville, Bristol BS3 1TF. Mediterranean food, drinks, open until around 11 pm in the week, 12 at the weekend.

- *Café Sazz*, 232 North Street, don't be put off by the gaudy décor, the food is great especially the Turkish specialities.
- *Souk Kitchen*, 277 North Street, lovely Middle Eastern cooking. *El Rincón*, 298 North Street, lovely Spanish restaurant bar, open Tues-Sun.
- *Thali cafe*, 278 North Street, Bristol BS3 1TF (next door to the Tobacco Factory). Good curry.
- *Al's Tikka Grill*, 33 Ashton Road, Ashton, Bristol (alongside Greville Smyth park). Traditional British Cafe by day serving great, cheap staple food, transforms into a 'Bring your Own' Indian Restaurant by night.
- *Fishminster*, 267 North Street, freshly cooked fish and chips to eat in or take away. North Street has quite a few cafes and bistro/bars so it is worth a wander along.
- *Arnolfini's café/bar*
- *Watershed* has a nice bar serving food upstairs, there are also numerous chain bistros/bars towards the Millennium Square area.
