Comfor Tec adhesive strips are applied to the back of the element so the floor can be fixed to the subfloor in an easy and stable way that results in acoustics that are said to sound similar to a full glue down floor.

Floor to curb contamination

DYCEM has introduced a new contamination control floor edging system for the pharmaceutical sector.

Designed to offer an audit compliant clear demarcation zone that removes foot and wheel contamination and reduces 75% of airborne contamination, the edging system is said to offer a low profile (just over 3mm) that allows smooth movement of equipment.

The 'complete seal' edging is said to prevent the ingress of microbial contamination and stop water from

seeping under the floor and resulting in bacteria growth.

Designed to offer an absolute bond to the floor, the company says it has a 'clean peel' that does not leave trace or residue.

Audit details can be reverse-printed on the edging system so that decontamination zones are clearly visible. Testing indicates high resistance to steam and chemical cleaning agents and sporicidals.
